The IB Security Assistant recruitment process consists of three tiers:

- **Tier I:** Objective Type Test (Written Exam)
- **Tier II:** Descriptive Test & Spoken Ability (Qualifying Nature)
- **Tier III:** Interview/Personality Test

Tier II Syllabus

Preparation Tips

For Tier I:

1. **Time Management:** With 100 questions in 60 minutes, allocate approximately 36 seconds per question
2. **Negative Marking Strategy:** Attempt questions you're confident about first
3. **Current Affairs:** Stay updated with last 6 months' national and international events
4. **Practice:** Solve previous year papers and mock tests regularly

For Tier II:

1. **Language Skills:** Practice translation between local language and English
2. **Spoken Test:** Focus on pronunciation, fluency, and clarity in local language

For Tier III:

1. **Stay Updated:** Keep abreast of current affairs and general knowledge
 2. **Communication:** Practice speaking clearly and confidently
 3. **Personality Development:** Work on overall personality traits and presence
